

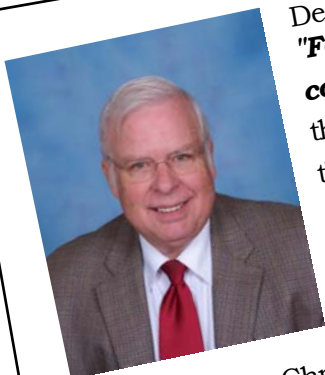

FaithHeritage Christian Academy has as its philosophical foundation the infallible Word of God. The goal of all education, according to 1 Corinthians 10:31 “*Whether therefore ye eat, or drink, or whatsoever ye do, do all to the glory of God.*”, is to help man achieve life’s purpose: to glorify God. As the explicit revelation of this God, whom men are to know and serve, the Word of God provides the primary instrument toward the goal of education. In light of this, emphasis must be placed on learning, understanding, applying, and memorizing the Scriptures during the school day.

Educational Philosophy

According to Psalm 24:1, all of creation in all its aspects belongs to God. In Genesis 1:27-28, we are told that man was created in God’s image and was given charge as a steward of this creation. In light of this charge, men are to be taught to understand the creation in all its aspects, not as an end in itself, but as a means to knowing and serving God. Hence, an effective education will expose students to the fullness of creation and give them skills necessary to serve God as well as society. Since a true understanding of the world in which we live cannot be gained apart from knowledge of its Creator, all aspects of the educational curriculum should be **distinctly Christian**, taking into account God’s revelation of Himself.

A primary portion of our service to God as outlined in both Exodus 20:1-17 and Matthew 19:19 is to center around loving our neighbors. To this end, a full education should include a substantial emphasis on acquiring and understanding the tools for communication and learning. In addition, students

should understand the history and state of the culture within which they will serve God through their dealings with their neighbors.

Recognizing that parents have been given by God the basic responsibility of training and educating their children, FHCA *strongly encourages parents to be active in the instruction of their child(ren)*. Parents are to be aware of the process, content, and progress of their child’s education. Parents also may contribute to instruction in many ways. Lunch duty, substitute teaching, teaching a specialized subject such as art or music, helping with reading groups, serving with the parent-teacher organization, and being involved in field trips are some of the ways in which parents can be active in their child’s education.

Statement of Beliefs

- We believe that the Bible, both the Old and New Testaments, was inspired by God, and is infallible and inerrant, and our only authoritative rule in matters of faith and practice.
- We believe in divine creation; that man was created by the direct act of God and in the image of God.
- We believe that Adam and Eve, in yielding to the temptation of Satan, became fallen creatures. We believe that all men, therefore, are born in sin.
- We believe in the incarnation, the Virgin Birth, and the deity of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.
- We believe in His vicarious and substitutionary Atonement for the sins of mankind by the shedding of His blood on the cross.
- We believe in the resurrection of His body from the tomb, His ascension to Heaven, and that He is personally coming again.
- We believe in His power to save men from sin.
- We believe in the necessity of the New Birth, and that this New Birth is through the regeneration by the Holy Spirit.
- We believe that salvation is by grace, through faith in the atoning blood of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

Enrollment Information for 2010-2011

Registration Fee—\$275 per family

The deadline for current students and their siblings to reserve a seat in next years class is February 26th. The Registration Fee is \$275 *per family*. The Registration Fee is **NON-REFUNDABLE** except for family emergencies and with the authorization of the Headmaster. The Registration Fee for Kindergarten students may be paid starting February 1st and Kindergarten students will be admitted on a first come-first served basis after the parents and student have met with the Headmaster.

Tuition for School Year 2010-2011

In response to many of our parent's calls to simplify our tuition and fee schedule, we will continue using a single "tuition" charge with only slight changes. This single tuition charge includes all of the individual charges, book fees, semester fees, and insurance fees, etc.

This single tuition charge reflects a minimal increase. We are not happy about having to increase our charges again but want to be good stewards of the funds God blesses us with and not have to devote all "church family" income to subsidize the academy's operating expenses. As we work to expand our curriculum and include additional faculty as necessary our per student costs increase. Our church family has consistently subsidized our operations as part of our church's mission and ministry outreach program and prayerfully will continue to do so. Once again, we are trying to work with all of our students and their parents by keeping costs as affordable as possible.

Tuition: Payment is due by the 10th of each month June—May. These payments may be brought or mailed to FaithHeritage Christian Academy, P.O. Box 157 Millington, TN 38053. If payment is not received by the 11th your student will not be allowed to return to class until paid. All payments received are **NON REFUNDABLE** There may be additional fees for special courses or other activities i.e., Biology, Art, Home Ec., Athletics, and Fine Arts competition etc. The academy will try to restrict expenses to those quoted above.

Discounts for families with multiple on-campus students: FaithHeritage Christian Academy offers the following discounts: 3rd student—5% discount off tuition; 4th student—7% discount off tuition; 5th student—10% discount off tuition; 6th student or more—15% off tuition.



Dress Policy *(brief summary)*

The FHCA dress code is applicable for **all** students, both on-campus and off-campus, who come to the school campus at **any** time. Young ladies may wear slacks, jumpers, shorts, and skirts, khaki or navy blue in color. Skirts and shorts **must** cover the knees. Young men must wear slacks or shorts, khaki or navy blue in color, (with belts) and shorts **must** cover the knees. *(If you can see the knees, the clothing is too short.)* Slacks, pants, shorts, etc. **must be hemmed or cuffed and plain or pleated front with no decorations.** Young ladies and men must wear FHCA monogrammed shirts (short or long sleeved) which may be purchased on campus. *Shirts must be tucked in at all times.* Tennis shoes and leather shoes and loafers are acceptable shoes, **always** with socks. No open toe shoes or sandals may be worn for safety reasons. **(The full dress code policy may be found in the Parent-Student handbook and should be reviewed. This brief summary is in no way to be considered comprehensive.)**


